Alvin Brent Battle, on or about June 2022 through July 2022, in the County of Calhoun and State of Florida, committed the offense of one (1) count of Conspiracy to Introduce Contraband to wit: tobacco contrary to Florida Statutes Florida Statutes 777.04/944.47(1)(a)(4), (3 DEG FELONY), and

Alvin Brent Battle, on or about June 2022 through July 2022, in the County of Calhoun and State of Florida, committed the offense of one (1) count of Conspiracy to Introduce Contraband to wit: cell phones contrary to Florida Statutes Florida Statutes 777.04/944.47(1)(a)(6), (3 DEG FELONY), and



NARRATIVE OF THE FACTUAL BASIS FOR PROBABLE CAUSE: The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe that the heretofore named defendant did commit the violations of law as stated above and the factual basis for this belief is as follows:

Your Affiant is Senior Inspector William "Eddie" Dalton (SI Dalton) of the Office of the Inspector General, Florida Department of Corrections.

Your Affiant has probable cause to believe in or about June 2022 through July 2022, Calhoun Correctional Institution (CCI) PRIDE employee, Alvin Brent Battle (Mr. Battle), in the County of Calhoun and the State of Florida, did commit the following: one (1) count of the criminal offense of Unlawful Compensation or Reward for Official Behavior in violation of Florida Statute 838.016 (1), when Mr. Battle did actually and intentionally receive one (1) electronic money transfer to personally benefit Mr. Battle, for the nonperformance of his lawful duty as a PRIDE employee at CCI, to wit: the overlooking, permitting, and/or enabling the violation of Florida criminal laws and the Departmental disciplinary rules, specifically conspiring to introduce contraband; one (1) count of Conspiracy to Introduce Contraband (tobacco) in violation of Florida Statute 777.04/944.47(1)(a)(4), when Mr. Battle did actually and intentionally conspire with inmates, inmates' family members, and/or known associates of inmates and received payment for introducing contraband into the secure perimeter of CCI; one (1) count of Conspiracy to Introduce Contraband (cellular telephones) in violation of Florida Statute 777.04/944.47(1)(a)(6), when Mr. Battle did actually and intentionally conspire with inmates, inmates' family members, and/or known associates of inmates and received payment for introducing contraband into the secure perimeter of CCI; one (1) count of Conspiracy to Introduce Contraband (Molly, K-2, and other narcotics) in violation of Florida Statute 777.04/944.47(1)(a)(4), when Mr. Battle did actually and intentionally conspire with inmates, inmates' family members, and/or known associates of inmates and received payment for introducing contraband into the secure perimeter of CCI; and one (1) count of the criminal offense of Interference with Prisoners, in violation of Florida Statute 944.39, when Mr. Battle engaged in a business and personal relationship with inmate(s) who were under his direct supervision and while incarcerated within the Florida Department of Corrections (FDC), and while doing so allowed inmate(s) to violate laws of the State of Florida and rules of the Department of Corrections.

Mr. Battle began his career as Correctional Officer with FDC at CCI on February 20, 1989. Mr. Battle retired from CCI in 2014. After Mr. Battle retired from CCI, he immediately gained employment with PRIDE at CCI. During Mr. Battle's employment at CCI and PRIDE, he completed New Employee Training. As part of this training, Mr. Battle received training related to Equal Employment Opportunity & anti-harassment, instructions for reporting inappropriate inmate behavior, rules, procedures, policies related to new employees, and staff offender relationships are strictly prohibited.

On July 12, 2022, the Office of the Inspector General received information indicating Correctional Officer Clifford O'Brian (Officer O'Brian) conducted a search of the bathroom at the automotive shop at CCI. During the search, Officer O'Brian located ten (10) packs of cigarettes, seven (7) cell phone SIMs card keys, and seven (7) cell phone owner manuals in the trash can. Officer O'Brian also located an inmate poncho belonging to inmate Isaac Davis DC#896942 (Inmate Davis) beside the trash can. When questioned, Inmate Davis advised Mr. Battle instructed him to remove the items from the white van that belongs to PRIDE and place them in the bathroom for someone to pick up.

Based on the totality of the circumstances, the Office of the Inspector General initiated a criminal investigation into the allegations Mr. Battle was involved in introducing contraband into the secure perimeter CCI.

Fixed wing video from the warehouse confirmed Mr. Battle was driving the white PRIDE van on July 12, 2022. Fixed wing video shows Mr. Battle unlock the front passenger side door of the van and allow Inmate Davis to enter the vehicle. Inmate Davis is seen removing an item from under the passenger seat. Inmate Davis begins to conceal item(s) in his waist band as Mr. Battle gives Inmate Davis a dolly.

Sworn testimony was obtained from inmate Davis who was housed at CCI and assigned to work outside the secure perimeter with Mr. Battle on July 12, 2022. According to Inmate Davis, on July 12, 2022, Mr. Battle asked Inmate Davis to retrieve items from under the passenger seat of the white PRIDE van. Inmate Davis removed a Walmart bag from under the front passenger seat and observed several packs of 305 cigarettes and cellular telephone paperwork. Mr. Battle's instructed Inmate Davis to take the cigarettes to the bathroom and someone else will pick them up. Inmate Davis concealed the cigarettes and the cell phone paperwork in his waist band and took them to the bathroom behind the automotive shop as he was instructed.

Sworn post Miranda testimony was obtained from Mr. Battle. Mr. Battle indicated on July 12, 2022, he was employed with PRIDE at CCI. Prior to being employed at PRIDE, Mr. Battle worked with FDC as a Correctional Officer at CCI. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Mr. Battle uses the van daily to run errands in the vicinity of Blountstown, Florida. Mr. Battle started driving the van several months ago. When Mr. Battle started driving the van, he conducted a search of the van to make sure the previous driver did not leave anything in the vehicle. During the search, Mr. Battle

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located several contraband items to include the Walmart bag with cigarettes under the front passenger seat. Mr. Battle removed the other contraband but left the cigarettes under the seat for several months. On July 12, 2022, upon returning to CCI, Mr. Battle remembered the cigarettes were under the seat. Mr. Battle instructed Inmate Davis to dispose of the cigarettes for him. Mr. Battle did not report finding any contraband in the van to his supervisor or security staff.

On July 12, 2022, Mr. Battle provided verbal and written consent to search his personal vehicle, a red Toyota Truck bearing Florida tag [REDACTED] which was situated on FDC property at CCI. During a search of Mr. Battle's vehicle, the following items were located: a brown paper bag in plain view between the front driver's seat and the door jam containing two sandwich bags full of loose cigarette tobacco, five (5) empty 305 brand cigarette packs and an empty 305 brand cigarette carton, several notes requesting tobacco, K2, molly, mobile hotspots, and cellular telephones and a United States Postal money order in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500.00).

Records were obtained from United States Postal Service (USPS) in reference to the five-hundred-dollar (\$500.00) money order located in Mr. Battle's vehicle. According to USPS records, the money order was made payable to B Battle. The money order was purchased with debit card [REDACTED] on June 8, 2022, in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500.00).

During this investigation, your Affiant requested, obtained, and served subpoenas to Block Inc., the parent company of Cash App, requesting money transfer records related to Cash App debit card [REDACTED] in response to the subpoena, Block Inc. provided records related to debit card [REDACTED] and the associated Cash App account.

According to Block Inc, the subscriber/account holder information for debit card [REDACTED] is as follows: Identity Verification Name: Wade Cooper, DOB- 10/28/1975, last four of SSN: [REDACTED] telephone numbers: 904-250-7888, and address: 4422 Detaille Drive Jacksonville, FL 32209.

Based on sworn testimony and Cash App records, Mr. Cooper's Cash App account was identified as an account facilitating numerous payment(s) for introducing contraband at CCI. In June and July 2022 alone, Mr. Cooper received twenty (20) separate money transfers from inmates housed at CCI.

Block Inc. records indicate, on June 9, 2022, a \$500.00 debit card purchase for a USPS money order posted to Mr. Cooper's Cash App account. Mr. Cooper's Cash App records confirm the purchase of the USPS money order issued to Mr. Battle on June 8, 2022. Mr. Cooper was identified as a known associate of multiple inmates housed at CCI during the time electronic money transfers were sent and while Mr. Battle was employed at CCI.

Mr. Battle's receipt of payment from Mr. Cooper on June 8, 2022, coupled with his possession of notes requesting various contraband items (IE: tobacco, K2, molly, mobile hotspots, and cellular telephones) and his possession of contraband on July 12, 2022, indicate Mr. Battle is responsible for the introduction of contraband items paid for by the money sent to Mr. Cooper by the inmates housed at CCI.

Through your Affiant's experience in conducting similar investigations, inmates frequently purchase contraband items from other inmates at their assigned facility and pay for the contraband through Cash App payments. The inmate selling the contraband commonly provides the inmate purchasing the contraband with a Cash App account to have money sent. The inmate purchaser often never knows the identity of the person they are paying. Staff members who introduce contraband and receive payment for the contraband, often communicate with only one inmate who works as a go-between with other inmates to protect the corrupt staff member's identity and avoid detection by law enforcement.
