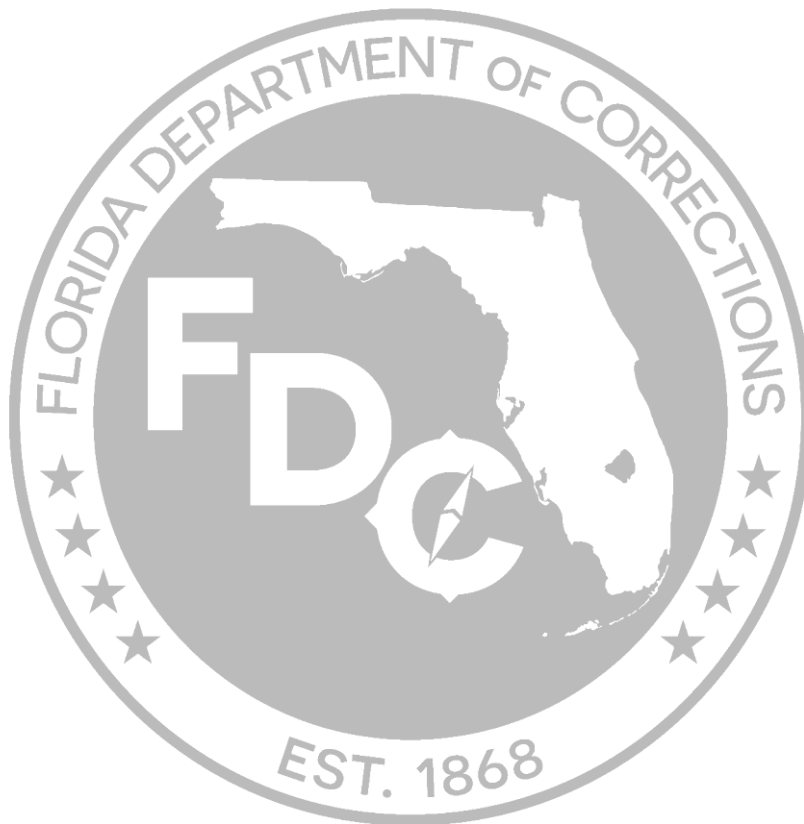

Inmate Profile Summary

This report summarizes county information mandated to be collected by F.S. § 951.23(2) and submitted to Florida Department of Corrections. It provides a monthly profile of inmate populations inside Florida's detention facilities. For counties that can not submit data using standardized instruments it provides approximated data.

Table 1, pages 1 & 2, features the Average Daily Population and incarceration rate in each county.

Table 2, pages 3 & 4, lists the number and percent of felony and misdemeanor pretrial inmates at each detention facility.

The Jail Population Summary (Table 3, page 5) lists detention center totals for the year to date.

Average Daily Population

As reported, there were an estimated 52,484 inmates in Florida's county detention facilities during the month of January 2020. In comparison, in January 2019, there were 54,378 inmates incarcerated by county facilities in Florida. This is a 3.5% decrease from last year.

If the information transmitted to the Department was for the current month, but it did not conform to the standards established by the instrument developed per §951.23(2), then only the month's population average is provided and "Date Reported" will reflect the current month. Otherwise no date infers that the facility reported timely and per the §951.23(2) instrument standard.
