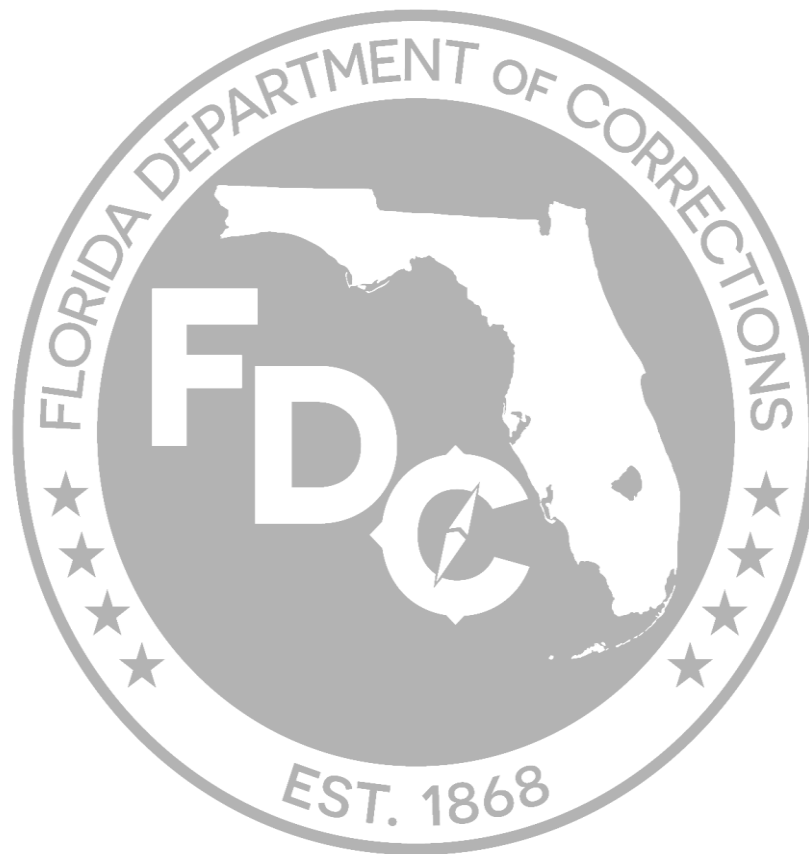

Inmate Profile Summary

This report summarizes county information mandated to be collected by F.S. § 951.23(2) and submitted to Florida Department of Corrections. It provides a monthly profile of inmate populations inside Florida's detention facilities. For counties that can not submit data using standardized instruments it provides approximated data.

Table 1, pages 1 & 2, features the Average Daily Population and incarceration rate in each county.

Table 2, pages 3 & 4, lists the number and percent of felony and misdemeanor pretrial inmates at each detention facility.

The Jail Population Summary (Table 3, page 5) lists detention center totals for the year to date.

Average Daily Population

As reported, there were an estimated 48,602 inmates in Florida's county detention facilities during the month of October. In comparison, in October 2019, there were 55,524 inmates incarcerated by county facilities in Florida. This is a 12.5% decrease from last year.

Otherwise no date infers that the facility reported timely and per the §951.23(2) instrument standard.
